**LEADERSHIP EDUCATION AND DICIPLESHP STUDIES**

**Curriculum Overview:** This course is designed to increase the theological understanding and technical competency of the minister (ordained and unordained) in the performance of public ministry. The topics to be covered include worship planning, presiding skills, public prayer, exegetical preaching, and the eight sacraments of the Community of Christ. Emphasis will be on the preaching and sacraments units of the course. The course will include a special assignment for further development of public ministry skills.

**There are three options to participate in LEADS. They are:**

**LEADERSHIP TRACK**—Participate in all 13 courses plus two supplemental courses. You may make-up up to three courses or partial courses with the instructor. Certificate Option 1.

**MINISTRY TRACK**— Participate in nine courses plus two supplemental courses. You may make-up up to three courses or partial courses with the instructor. Certificate Option 2.

**SELF-SELECTED COURSES** — Any course may be taken although no credit will be offered for the course.
